## The Ken Wood Cup

The Club's perpetual major award, the "Ken Wood Cup" is awarded each season to the outstanding member of the club. This award was first awarded in the 1947/48 season in memory of Sergeant Ken Wood, who sadly died during World War II. When deciding the recipient of this award, the general committee takes into account performances on the cricket field, sportsmanship and other services rendered to the club.

The **nominees** for this award for the 2008/2009 season are listed below and include a short synopsis of their performances on and off the field.

#### **Amit Gade**

Amit captained the C One Day side to a grand final game, was a regular attendant at training, assisted with the winter-comp and helped recruit valuable new players to the 'bridge. Amit was also a committee member during the year. In addition he had a stellar year performance wise, taking in excess of 30 wickets at an average of ~15 and scoring a bucket loads of runs, including a century. Amit also picked up the association award for C-Grade averages.

#### **Peter Stankovic**

Peter captained the C Grade side throughout the year without so much as a whimper with regard to player availability. He also assisted greatly with getting the Northbridge honour board off the ground and onto the World Wide Web. This is all in addition to holding a senior position on the committee and providing many words of wisdom in that capacity. Peter also had a good year with the bat and picked up the association Achievement Award for his ongoing commitment to cricket.

#### **David Stonestreet**

Stoney put in a great deal of work in the early stages of the year before anybody else had even got the whiff of fresh cut grass and leather. Stoney assisted with the stock-take of the club's gear and with shopping for all the clubs new equipment. He also assisted with organising the Northbridge day at the cricket. He was an eager participant in the committee meetings and assisted with organising the gala day events. Stoney did not have a great year with the bat but was ever ready to support the A-Res team as a specialist fielder in their finals campaign.

## **Mitch Nicholls**

Mitch was an email dynamo during the season. Last count of the President's email indicated he had 77 emails from Mitch between Jan 5th and April 5th. Mitch was a new member to the committee and was pulled in to provide assistance to Mark Naglost as club secretary. His initial duties were amorphous which resulted in him picking up more and more roles. First he was responsible for sending the MyCricket notifications then he became Chairman of Selectors and quasi responsible for the selection of the B Grade side, and almost totally responsible for MyCricket and permit applications through-out the year. When team selections had not been made by a Thursday afternoon he was the one that chased the captains. Mitch basically ensured, with the captain's help, that we actually fielded cricket team's week in and week out. This was all done while juggling the birth of his new son. Mitch again played games across multiple grades during the season, indicating his commitment to the club even when he wasn't available for a full 2 weeks. He was a solid contributor to the A Res pace attack and had a handy year with the bat, chipping in when most required.



#### Mitch Whyman

Mitch has lead from the front again this year, throwing ideas around like cupcakes and continually challenging the committee (with the ideas and the emails). Some of the ideas he gave birth to this year include; the 90th anniversary gala bash, the 90th anniversary stocking stuffier (cap), a cooperative agreement with junior feeder clubs, the Northbridge sports club, the pedal bar and more. He is so dedicated he even attended one of the committee meetings by telephone conference from the Gold Coast where he was on holidays. He acted as distributor for the t-shirts and caps at the start of the season when he was out of action with an injury, and almost singlehandedly organised the gala day luncheon. The A Reserve team was also honoured with the appearance of Brett Lee to support them at the outset of the grand final, thanks again to David.

The **winner** of the Ken Wood Cup this year is **Mitch Whyman.** Congratulations to **Mitch** for his outstanding commitment and service to the club this year. This is the third time Mitch has won this prestigious award and clearly demonstrates his ongoing commitment to the club. Mitch's tireless work for the club is almost expected of him, and often goes unnoticed.

His role as Honorary President results in him doing all the jobs that no-one else is willing to take on, and many more that no-one is even aware of. Not only does he complete all these without hesitation, he also has the drive and commitment to come up with new ways and means of improving the club.



He also often puts the club before his own interests when team selections are on the table; but when he does step foot on the hallowed turf, his will and determination inspires all, and his bowling prowess is often at its peak when the chips are down. A very worthy recipient and someone we are all proud to call our Honorary President. Well done Mitch!

## The Stephen Peak Trophy

The Stephen Peak Trophy is a new award introduced two seasons ago. Stephen played cricket for Northbridge, was our Club Treasurer and Vice Captain of our A-Reserve Grade Team in 2005/06. Stephen tragically passed away in the off-season at the age of 33. This award is in memory of Stephen and his commitment on and off the field. The award is designed to recognise the Players Player – voted by the players on a 3-2-1 basis, week in week out. Any member, in any team of the club can win this award.

This 3-2-1 votes are scaled based on the number of games played by each team. This is to compensate for our One Day sides, which play a significantly larger number of games each season compared to our other teams.
