This 3-2-1 votes are scaled based on the number of games played by each team. This is to compensate for our One Day sides, which play a significantly larger number of games each season compared to our other teams.

A Grade Captains Report – Amrish Bhatia

As I provide an outline of the 2012-2013 summer season, I take the opportunity to first thank my President Mitch Whyman, and the executive at NCC in giving me the opportunity to continue as captain of the club's flagship side.

Once again, I can say on behalf of each of the boys who played in my squad, that we all enjoyed our cricket above anything else. Of course winning would have been nice too – we started the season with wins, showing real strength but unfortunately weren't able to sustain it through the season.

So whilst last year was rebuilding, this year was about taking that forward and that we did. As we build and grow a core, I am confident that the club and our side is in a strong position going into the '13-'14 season.

A huge thanks to Aadil Khalil – it was great to have him back with the club – and he played a pivotal role in supporting me and rallying the squad. Not to mention hearty “congratulations” too – Aadil won the 2012 – 2013 NSCA association batting award (again!) scoring 500 runs! He is a class act and I am certain he will continue to dominate the association batting charts. I missed Benny Maw (though congratulations on the birth of Thomas a budding NCC cricketer), but Aadil stepped in/up. Along with Aadil, a sincere thanks to Mitch Nicholls who was a monumental support through the season – not only to all teams and the club as secretary, but to the A grade squad with covers, rain logistics, player management etc. Lots of others helped too – Aqif Khalil, Chris Olver, Steve Hill, John Mitchell, Anirudh Narasimhan, Mike Smith and the list goes on ... thank you guys!

After the first game of the season was washed out to signify what was to be another wet summer, the season started for us with a super win at Koola against West Pymble Chaps. After putting runs on the board (Aadil 70, Kanu 40) we bowled them out for a paltry 90 (Greeny mesmerising with 5-23 and Mitch N 2-17). Koola stayed a happy ground with an almost outright win against the team that went on to win the title – Kirribilli Crusaders Red. This performance showed the strength of my team – a fantastic effort! Anirudh got an unbeaten 115 in a majestic innings supported by a brutal unbeaten 50 from Kanu. Greeny on a late Sunday afternoon with some awesome bowling almost ran through the side but their last wicket held out for 5 overs to deny us the outright win.

Other noteworthy performances as the season wore on – Aadil got back to back 80's in the next two games, one in an effort that protected us from an outright after being asked to bat again. Aqif showed he could bowl with a 2fer in 4 overs almost helping us win against North Shore and Zaeem showed his fitness and intensity with a spell of 23-5-4-66 on a day when the temperature crossed 40 degrees (outstanding spell)! Steven then matched this bowling with a spell of 8-1-5-43 against West Pymble in a match we almost won when Sajjad flayed 75 with 8 fours and 4 sixes but we managed to clinch defeat from the jaws of victory! Mitch Nicholls top scored with a well hit 39 against the Kirribilli attack, that innings making him a true all-rounder for the rest of the season and onwards. Anirudh 8-2-2-17 in Round 9 versus Nth Sydney Leagues before rain halted and robbed our strong march towards their small total. Zaeem (14 runs batting at #3) and Mitch (45 quick runs with 7 fours and a six), both turning into batsmen in our second dig after Cammeray had just managed to inch ahead on the first innings. Divyesh Thakkar debuting with a solid 33 supported by John getting an unbeaten half century, then unleashing the dangerous Aadil inswing (ala Waqar Younis), yet losing narrowly to Chaps. Back at Koola we were robbed of victory by rain as West Pymble struggled against an outstanding new ball spell from Mitch N and Aadil after Anirudh and the skipper got half centuries

to put adequate runs on the board. And as we ended the season, Jason showed his batting prowess with a fine 29 that almost got us home against the top ranked Kirribilli side in a low scoring game. Unfortunately due to injuries and unavailability we could not field the strongest side in every match so as the tournament grew older so did our results.

It was fantastic to have Greeny back and bowling beautifully! And when he teamed with Mitch Nicholls who recovered his pace and swing, our opening bowling was on song – merrily swinging and cutting the opposition away. Once Aadil was fit to bowl (late in the season), the opposition batsmen told us they were scared of him. It was great to see Kanu play his part though the timing to have a child wasn't as good as that of his batting, and he couldn't participate after a few games. Anirudh returned on a full time basis and his all-round ability was a plus (though Aadil may disagree!). The old war horse in Steve continues to defy his age (what age!) and once again showed skill with both bat and ball and sliding around on the field. John Mitchell continues to remain one of the most liked cricketers in the team and with the young boys surrounding us in Justin Reiss, Matt Lording and the Thakkar brothers (Naynesh and Divyesh) the team has a bright future. Aadil pulled in a few players – hopefully they will play for NCC next season – Sajjad and Mohammed – both good cricketers. Zaeem once elevated to the side showed why he loves bowling – a spell of 25 overs on a 40 degree day at Koola was just outstanding! Jason brought fresh enthusiasm and humour, and showed he can get runs in the coming season. We missed Pradeep Gadepally who returned to India after a few games. And thanks to Alex Davey, Mike Smith, Rakesh Radhakrishnan, Mitch Whyman, Andrew Belger, Daniel Zatz, Yasir Zia, Nick May, Scotty Owen-Lloyd, Simon Chappel and Victor Mudyara too for playing with us.

A few injuries dogged us – Aadil's shoulder, Mitch's hamstring, Amrish's finger, coupled with babies, overseas travel and wives that made a few of our stalwarts unavailable, disrupted me fielding the strongest team in every game. Yet a few of the results went our way and it is my endeavour to make the next season count ... I look forward to the return of Ben Maw, Abhishek Sharma and Kanu Partha and if Greeny and Mitch can stay available and fit along this will be a team that will take some beating! Go the Bridge ... Thanks Guys!

B Grade – Division 2 Captain's Report – Peter Stankovic

The 2012/13 season for C Grade two day team was different from prior years because our team played in a combined B and C grade competition. Although two ladders were in place, one for Division One (B Grade sides) and one for Division Two (C Grade sides), we played all teams which proved to be enjoyable. In my view the standard between the two divisions was not great. If anything Division One sides simply carried a greater number of strong cricketers than the Division Two sides.

What was noteworthy for our team was the inclusion of a number of younger players – Justin Reiss, Michael Stankovic, Divyesh Thakkar, Naynesh Thakkar and Yasir Zia – three of which were new to Northbridge. The club will prosper if it can continue to attract and maintain younger members.

We had a handful of regulars from the previous season but of the 34 players who represented the side only 5 of them participated in 10 or more matches. This was disappointing as I considered our best side would have been competitive with most opponents.

Highlights:

- Andrew Belger scored a club record of 263 not out against North Sydney Leagues (Division 2). The previous record was held by Jesus Luque who scored 211 not out in the 2006/07 season.
- Rishi Mehta's hat trick in round one against North Shore.
- Andrew Belger's consistency. He scored three hundreds, two fifties and was not dismissed on four occasions to score 749 runs at an average of 124.83.
- Two day match against Macquarie University. On day one rain from days before had made the pitch and surrounding areas difficult for play. Players from both teams acted as a unit to clear the wet and a 1:30 pm start was possible. Day two was also rain affected but because Northbridge was 2/70 chasing 104, Macquarie University players did not help to clear the wet. Bad sports.
- In our penultimate match at Northbridge Oval, a young tearaway bowler enjoyed bowling bouncers. He did this to every batsmen except to Belger. However towards the end of the innings he bounced Andrew who took exception to this treatment. He hooked the delivery not only over the boundary but over the high fence protecting balls hitting the golf course, then proceeded to have words with the bowler. The bowler not used to being hit for six nor being sledged wanted to start a fight. Intervention from calmer souls stopped the incident becoming ugly.

Although one could suggest the season was all about Andrew Belger with the remainder of the team being onlookers, this was not the case as we had plenty of interesting times and laughs. I would like to thank all participants who made the season enjoyable, both on and off the field.
